MASD Athletes Named to All-State Soccer Team

Moon Area High School seniors Jordan Calabria, Mara Hricik and Caroline Keefer recently were named to the 2009 Pennsylvania Female All-State Soccer Team. Selected by high school soccer coaches from across the commonwealth, the achievement caps an incredible career for the trio of four-year letter winners and team captains, who helped their team to an undefeated regular season and will go on to NCAA soccer careers.

In the 2009 season, the Moon Lady Tigers were ranked No. 1 in WPIAL AAA Girls competition, No. 4 by Pennsylvania Soccer Coaches Association and No. 35 nationally by ESPN Magazine.

Jordan, a midfielder, also was named a National Soccer Coaches Association of America/Adidas Regional All-American and was honored as a three-time all-section and two-time all-WPIAL selection. This season, she scored 19 goals and added 15 assists to be named Post-Gazette West Player of the Year and appeared on the Post-Gazette and Pittsburgh Tribune-Review All-Star teams. She will continue her career at Saint Bonaventure University.

Mara, a goalkeeper, recorded 17 shutouts this season and finished her record-setting career with 53 shutouts, the highest in Moon Area High School history. She also was a three-time all-section and an all-WPIAL selection. She was named a Post-Gazette West All-Star and to the Post-Gazette and Pittsburgh Tribune-Review All-Star teams. She will continue her soccer career at a four-year university.

Caroline, a midfielder/defender, finished her high school career with 64 goals and 56 assists. She also was a three-time all-section and two-time all-WPIAL selection. In 2008, she was named Post-Gazette West Player of the Year, and in 2009 was selected as a Post-Gazette West All-Star and to the newspaper's All-Area Team. She will continue her soccer career at the University of Pittsburgh.
