MASD Students Take Part in Special G-20 Lessons

Students throughout Moon Area School District had special current events lessons this week centered around the G-20 Summit concurrently taking place in downtown Pittsburgh.

At McCormick Elementary, fifth-grade students in Shannon Martindale's and Sean Snowden's classes partnered to create posters which feature summit members flags and 20 facts about their assigned nation. Mrs. Martindale's class also created a special sign welcoming G-20 delegates to the area.

Hyde Elementary second-graders in Marcia Welsh's class, marked countries attending on a floor map after learning about the member nations.

At the middle school, Danielle Hadden's classes had a special lesson detailing what is the G-20, why the summit was being held in Pittsburgh and which issues will be discussed by world leaders. Teacher Susan McKenna incorporated G-20 into her keyboarding classes to help student build speed and accuracy with students striving to reach a goal of 20 words per minute with zero errors. A total of 91 percent of seventh-graders were able to reach the G-20.

Allard Elementary first-graders in Karen Lewis' class incorporated the summit into a special Show and Tell where each student colored their assigned nation's flag and shared a fact about the country. Students were urged to view the countries' cooperation as a lesson on how they should conduct themselves among their peers.
