407. STUDENT TEACHERS	
1. Purpose	The Board encourages cooperation with colleges and universities within the state in the training of student teachers. Therefore, the schools of this district will accept student teachers from accredited institutions of higher learning with which the district has a cooperative agreement approved by the Board.
2. Delegation of Responsibility	Under the direction of the Superintendent and in coordination with the school principals, student teachers from accredited colleges and universities may be assigned for student teaching experience in the school district.
SC 1418 Title 28 Sec. 23.43, 23.44, 23.45 Pol. 414	<p>Student teachers shall comply with the health examination of the state and the policy of this district as it applies to certificated personnel.</p> <p>Student teachers while serving in the schools of this district shall be responsible for their conduct to the supervising teacher and building principal.</p> <p>Student teachers assigned in the district school system shall be subject to the policies, practices, and procedures of the school system.</p>
SC 111	<p>Student Teachers shall report, on the designated form, arrests and convictions as required by law. In addition, school student teachers are required to report to the school district within seventy-two (72) hours any arrest or conviction of an offense listed in Section 111(e) that occurs after September 28, 2011. Failure to accurately report such arrests and convictions may, depending on the nature of the offense, subject the individual to criminal prosecution and/or termination of employment.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall ensure the distribution of student teachers throughout the district so that no single groups of pupils or teachers will be subject to excessive student teacher classroom hours.</p>

Student teachers or faculty of other educational institutions shall be offered the opportunity to visit and observe in the district schools. Such observers must be treated as any other visitor and shall be under the direct supervision of the principal.
