- The final tax levy resolutions for the 2010-11 fiscal year with no real estate tax rate increase and all other tax rates to remain unchanged as follows.

Real Estate Tax - It is resolved that under the authority granted by the Pennsylvania Public School Code of 1949, as amended, that the Moon Area School District imposes for general revenue purposes an annual tax of 21.30 mills or \$2.130 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation on all real estate situated in the Moon Township and Crescent Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania to be effective 12:01 A.M. on July 1, 2010 and to continue in force on a fiscal year basis without annual re-enactment unless the rate of tax is subsequently changed. In the opinion of the Board of Education of the Moon Area School District, said tax is necessitated by reason of the costs and expenses incident to the conduction of the activities and functions of the school district.

Other Taxes – All other tax rates are to remain unchanged and will continue to be levied at the following rates:

- The following resolution pertaining to the 2010-11 tax exempt lease purchase agreement:

**RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education of the Moon Area School District authorizes the Director of Fiscal and School Services to finalize the financing of the Technology Equipment Purchase Initiative for a total of \$550,000 at an annual percentage rate of 3.25%, with PNC Equipment Finance, its Agents or Assignee, in accordance with their proposal of June 7, 2010. The Board President of the Moon Area School District is hereby authorized to execute any and all legal documents necessary to conclude the financing of the tax exempt lease purchase agreement, subject to the approving opinion by the school district’s Solicitor Dodaro, Matta and Cambest.

- To authorize the purchase of technology equipment, as budgeted. The total cost of \$550,000 will be funded by the 2010-11 tax exempt lease purchase agreement.
- The following resolution pertaining to the 2010-11 tax exempt lease purchase agreement:

**RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education of the Moon Area School District authorizes the Director of Fiscal and School Services to finalize the financing of the New Curriculum Adoption Initiative for a total of \$845,000 at an annual percentage rate of 3.65%, with PNC Equipment Finance, its Agents or Assignee, in accordance with their proposal of June 7, 2011. The Board President of the Moon Area School District is hereby authorized to execute any and all legal documents necessary to conclude the financing of the tax exempt lease purchase agreement, subject to the approving opinion by the school district’s Solicitor Dodaro, Matta and Cambest.
