

**MOON AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING
MAY 24, 2010**

This is an unofficial report of the school board action at the meeting of the Board of School Directors on May 24, 2010. Official minutes of the meeting are maintained in the Central Office. Minutes will be available to the public after approval by the Board.

The Board Approved:

- The High School marching band to participate in the summer band camp at Washington and Jefferson College, August 1 – 6, 2010;
- The High School French Department to travel to Quebec, Canada, April 18-22, 2011;
- The AIU Fuel Consortium bid award for fuel supplies for the first half of the 2010-11 fiscal year;
- The bid for the irrigation system to Eagle Irrigation, Harrison City, PA at the low bid price of \$27,618.00;
- The bid for the 2010-2011 Middle School, High School Science supplies, Middle School and High School Tech Ed supplies, Art, Athletic, Custodial and Maintenance supplies totaling \$106,938.59;
- The additional approval of the March 8, 2010 PlanCon I for the high school construction project by the PA Department of Education;
- The filing of PlanCon Part F for the Middle School project with the PA Department of Education;
- The replacement of the district server, storage and backup infrastructure with a SAN-backed virtual infrastructure at an anticipated cost to the district of \$145,000 funded from Capital Reserve Fund, remaining Tech Refresh Funds and remaining Technology services and supplies budget;
- The replacement of the current district phone system with an Alcatel-Lucent Over IP telephone solution. Anticipated cost to the district is \$185,000 including installation and one year of support. Funding will come through the 2004 Bond Fund;
- The relocation of telecommunication services from the old High School to the new High School. Anticipated cost to the district is \$36,094, to be funded through the Capital Reserve Fund.
- The list of proposed resources for the K-12 English/Language Arts adoption for implementation in 2010-2011 at a cost not to exceed \$825,883;
- The list of proposed resources for the 6-12 French and Spanish adoption for implementation in 2010-2011 at a cost not to exceed \$66,904;
- An updated marketing textbook for implementation in 2010-2011 not to exceed \$8900;
