## ELEMENTARY *Art courses required in grades K-4*

- Students experience a wide variety of media in elementary art including drawing, painting, print making, fibers (weaving), and ceramics.

## MIDDLE SCHOOL *Art 5, 6, 7, 8, and Art Club*

- Participation in the Sewickley Library ExtravaganzART show
- Students design in-house graphics for school programs and team t-shirts
- Art students have won recognition at local, regional, and national levels such as in the RMU photography exhibit, Animal Friends, Bing national winner, etc.
- Exhibition of work at community businesses: Pittsburgh International Airport, Lawrenceville Art All Night, Sewickley Library, Clay Café, etc.
- Student artwork has been used to raise awareness and money for charities, disaster relief, cancer fundraising, etc.

## HIGH SCHOOL *Art 1, 2, 3, 4, AP Art History, Digital Photography 1 & 2, Digital Imaging 1, 2, & 3, Hands-On Art, Creative Art, Ceramics*

- MAHS hosts an annual art show in the spring to showcase student talent
- Savannah College of Art and Design and Ringling College of Art and Design have awarded scholarships for the past six years to advanced art students
